#### **Tournament Format:**

- 3 teams in each division. Competitive and Non- Competitive divisions
- 2 tiered divisions.
- Special attention to first games is given to teams traveling the long distances.

## **Rules and Regulations:**

- The tournament will follow the rules and regulations of the Canadian Hockey Association
- Games will consist of a 3 minute warm up followed by three 12 minute periods.

  Tied games will be broken with a 3 player shootout if needed. Final game will have a 5-minute sudden death overtime period, followed by a 3 player shootout if need.
- 3 points for a win, 2 points for O/T win, 1 point for O/T loss.
- Any girls high school hockey team is eligible to participate in the tournament
- Entry fee is \$340 per team; cheques can be made out to the St. Michael Catholic Secondary school. "Girls hockey tournament"
- OMHA carded referees will referee the games.
