RULES & REGULATIONS

Basic rules of basketball are in effect.

Fair Play Rule

Fair Play rules are in effect. All teams **must bring at least 10 players**. This will allow for the creation of 2 even lines. If you bring more than 10 players, they must be evenly rotated throughout the tournament. (Please see the rotation sheet included in this package).

Length of the Games

Round Robin

Round robin games will consist of 6 — 4 minute shifts, running time (a whistle will blow to indicate the end of a shift)

(No half time for round robin games)

Time-outs

2 — 30 second timeouts are available during round robin play.

Semi Finals and Finals

Games will consist of 8 —4 minute shifts running time (with a 2 minute half-time)

Last 2 minutes of the game are stop time.

3 — 1 minute timeouts are available during semis and finals

Scoring

Coaches must hand to the scoring table a sheet listing team players in numerical order.

Defense

Please note that the defensive rules are intended to make the game **fun** for the children and the tournament an **enjoyable** learning experience for all those involved. **Man to man defense format will be used.**

Players pick up their check as they come over the half court line. Following each basket the scoring team must return to half; **NO pressing. HELP** defense can be used. For example, if someone dribbles right past their defender and is on the way to the basket then a defender that is not the check can try to stop the person trying to score at the basket. This will happen just naturally for the boys and girls as a reflex to stop someone from scoring, which is fine. But keep in mind there is no **INTENTIONAL DOUBLE TEAMING OR TRAPPING.**

RULES & REGULATIONS

Fouls

- a. 5 per game per player.
- b. A technical foul is recorded as a personal foul.
- c. Bonus (2 shots) is in effect on the 5th team foul in any quarter (semi finals and finals).

Tie Breaker

- a. Head to Head result (two way tie)
- b. Least points against in round robin play (three way tie).
- C. Point differential (+/-) in round robin play (three way tie).

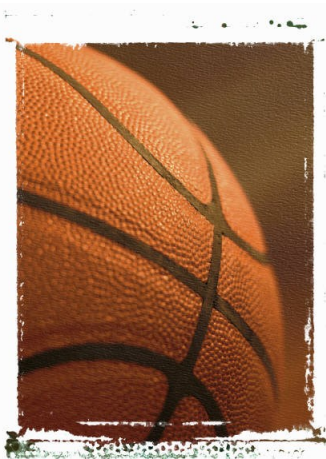
Draw

Following round robin play, the top two teams in each pool will advance to the semi-finals.

For the purposes of determining which teams will advance to the play-offs the team that wins the greatest number of games during pool play will be declared the first place finisher in their pool; the team with the second greatest number of wins will be declared the second place finisher in their pool.

Note to Coaches: Teams must be supervised at all times during the tournament. The behavior of team members and other people associated with the team is the responsibility of the coach. Referees and score keepers are to be respected by the coaches, players and parents. Coaches should remove from the floor any player who displays an unsportsmanlike attitude. The official, or the convener, may remove the player from the tournament entirely. Please show respect for opponents through good sportsmanship and respectable scores. The goal of the tournament is to provide a series of fun games and an enjoyable learning experience for all those involved. The decision of the referee and/or the convener is final.

Fair Play Rotation Sheet

Each school must fill out a rotation sheet and bring it with them to the tournament. The rotation sheet will be used to establish your 'fair play' shifts. Each team must have a minimum of 10 players. (The sheet does not need to be handed in to the scorers but you need to have it with you at all times).

How it works:

Example: for 10 players (shift one- players 1,2,3,4,5 shift two- players 6,7,8,9,10)

Example for 12 players (shift one- players 1,2,3,4,5 shift two—players 6,7,8,9,10 shift three- players 11, 12, 1, 2, 3 shift four –players 4,5,6,7,8 etc.)

****If a player is injured and can't continue playing, the next person on the list will be substituted on to finish the shift (coach can not pick the player to replace them)**

Ex. If players 3,4,5,6 and 7 are on and someone gets hurt, player 8 will replace him/her
