1. ENTRIES:

## 3. COURSE:

a) The course is mainly flat with cinder trail

Approximate distances:

- Grade 42.0 km
- Grade 52.5 km
- Grade 62.5 km
- Grade 73.0 km
- Grade 83.0 km


## 4. FINISH LINE:

Runners will receive a "place marker" at the finish line.
ONLY the top 3 runners will be asked to bring place markers to the score table.

## 5. SCHOOL DUTIES :

We will need one coach from each school at the finish line to help guide runners through the finish chute and/or to help lineup runners at the start line.

When lining up your runners at the start, please seed your runners so that the fastest 3 runners are at the front of the group. Let your group know ahead of time so that they are aware of how this will work before the race. We will have Blessed Trinity student volunteers (Grade 12 Recreation \& Leadership Class) to be marshals.
