Rules of Play:

General rules of competitive basketball are in effect with particular notice to the following;

- Round-Robin Games are 2 x 10 minute halves non-stop time. Two 30 second timeouts per team per game.
- Semi and Final Games will be 2 x 10 minute stop time. Semi and Final overtimes will be 2 minutes long with an additional timeout granted to each team.
- NO ZONE DEFENSE – referees will not call this...it is up to integrity of coaches to enforce!
- As we are not playing full court for any games - 3 point shots are not in effect for this tournament.
- Each team will bring and be responsible for their own practice balls.

Further Information:

- Coaches/teachers are asked to remind students not to wander the Blessed Trinity facility.
- Please use designated Visitor Parking Lots.
- This is a round robin tournament – all teams will play one another and the two best records will advance to the final.
- Round robin Tie breaker rule - 1. Head to head. 2. Least points allowed amongst tied teams. 3. Sudden death free throws
- Flagrant Fouls: at the discretion of the official, any flagrant foul charged against a player can result in the disqualification of that player from the game.
- Inappropriate language or gestures directed towards the officials or other players will not be tolerated. We must personify our Christian values at all times. Remember to “Play Like a Champion!”
